The objective of the Report is to monitor a core set of essential tobacco control policy initiatives, and to report on their implementation on a regular basis. The Report provides a platform for comparing, in a standardized manner, country progress towards the implementation of defined tobacco control measures.</p>	
<p>The purpose of this contractual arrangement is to collect data on prices of cigarettes as well as information in relation to tax administration from assigned countries within the WHO European Region (EURO), specifically, the 27 countries of the European Union.</p>	
<p>The consultancy may also be required to collect the price of selected alcoholic and non-alcoholic products.</p>

Main deliverable:	
Comprehensive data collected on key indicators for tobacco, alcoholic and non-alcoholic drinks covering the 27 EU countries.	

1. Collect data on price of one popular brand as well as a premium brand and the cheapest brand from two types of shops in each of the 27 EU countries.
2. Collect additional data in relation to:
 - a. Additional information on tax policy and tax administration.
 - b. Information on Electronic Nicotine Delivery Systems, Electronic Non-Nicotine Delivery Systems and Heated Tobacco Products prices.
 - c. Price of selected alcoholic and non-alcoholic products.
